*Twin Bill Performance of Veteran Bands Recreate the
Rock of Heart with the Eclectic Rock of Foreigner*

Dix Hills, New York, June 23, 2010 – The Dix Hills Performing Arts Center will present two top local tribute bands, “Heartless” recreating the music of classic Seattle rockers, Heart, and “Head Games,” playing the music of Foreigner, July 24 at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$25.

Heart



The New York area is privileged to have one of the most authentic Heart tribute bands in the nation, named for the only single from the band’s 1976 album, and recreating the music of sisters Ann and Nancy Wilson who trail blazed the hard-rock business as its first successful metal “girl group.” Originally a Led Zeppelin tribute band themselves, heart could hit the high notes and then some -- and then play the blistering guitar parts and even mandolin licks.

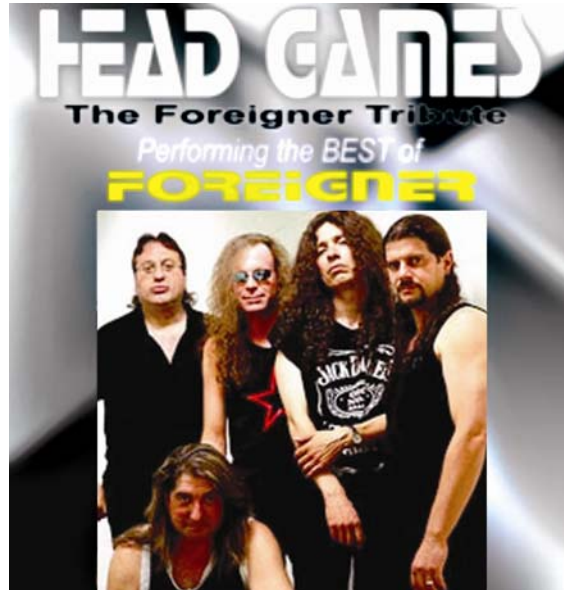
Heartless consists of a carefully selected and extremely talented group of musicians that regularly received rave reviews. They create the same definitive Heart sound and aura that has spanned more than three decades.

The band is led by Deana, who is lead vocalist and plays the role of Heart leader Ann Wilson. Diane, not really Deana’s sister, plays the Nancy Wilson role, focusing on both guitars and vocals. Craig Pullman plays keyboards and also sings, while Mike Orland plays additional guitar. Lenny Rocillo plays bass and vocals, while John LaSpina plays drums.

Head Games

For cover bands, copy bands, bar bands, and specialty acts, nothing can be more difficult to pull off than the sound and music of Foreigner. The original band's mix of rock'n'roll with rhythm and blues, classical, pop, funk and jazz took them to the forefront of popular music in the 1970's and '80's, culminating in their mega-hit "I Want To Know What Love Is."

Forged amidst rumors of the classic rock band's uncertain future, Head Game, the authentic Foreigner tribute band, not only re-create the live Foreigner sound, but captures the entire Foreigner concert experience. The band deftly reproduces Foreigner's "sight, sound, and soul," ensuring that a whole new generation of listeners will be exposed to some of the most influential music of our time.



Head Games is comprised of five seasoned musicians from the New York City area, where Mick Jones and Lou Graham originally formed their band. Head Games members share a common love for hard rocking music, and bring together all the same elements that made Foreigner hugely successful. Pulling members from numerous New York club bands, each member carries a musical history to rival the original bands.

Mike Ledesma sings lead vocals, while Billy Randall plays bass, Mike Dagostino plays drums, Jon Loyd performs on keyboards, and John Francese plays guitar and guitar synthesizer parts.
