**January 4, 2011, Dix Hills, NY** – The Dix Hills Performing Arts Center presents "Captain Jack," performing the greatest hits of Billy Joel on Jan. 29 at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$25. Captain Jack is a professional band that performs the music of Billy Joel and other timeless hits. The New York-based rock band is a frequent and popular attraction at regional rock clubs, and is also known for appearances at top charity, corporate and social events. Captain Jack has appeared with many internationally-acclaimed musicians and has garnered strong press coverage for headlining major fundraisers and other special events throughout the New York area.

The band features Michael Lipiner on lead vocals and keyboards; Harry Marks on guitar and vocals; Sal DiMarco on drums; Andrew Segale on saxophone, clarinet and percussion; and Frank Tassielli on bass guitar.

Captain Jack always aims to please by taking requests and surprising audiences with an energetic performance of the Piano Man's repertoire, beginning with some of Joel's earlier titles. Billy Joel is the sixth top selling recording artist in U.S. history and third highest selling solo artist according to the Recording Industry Association of America, which tracks music sales. Born in the Bronx,

raised in Hicksville, and now living out on the East End, Joel is a member of the Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame, the Songwriters Hall of Fame, and the Long Island Hall of Fame. He has 33 Top-40 hits to his credit, according to Billboard magazine.

Joel himself has also performed on the Dix Hills Performing Arts Center's stage, giving a master class for Five Towns College music students in 1993. Captain Jack has also been on the Dix Hills stage before. A video of the event is available on YouTube and featured on the band's website.
